1. Opening of the meeting

Dr. Robin Allen opened the meeting and welcomed the participants.

2. Election of Chairman

The delegate of Spain, Carlos Aldereguía, was elected Chairman of the meeting.

3. Review of vessel documentation

3.1. Dr. Allen informed the Group of the various origins of the documentation relating to vessels in possession of the IATTC.

3.2. The Group decided to approach the task by reviewing all the extant documents of all the vessels, and, with a view to speeding up the work, established a list of the possible cases that might be found. The cases would be:

1. Documentation from a surveying entity that vouches for the well volume, in m³, of the vessel
2. Documentation from, and vouched for by, the various governments.
3. Documentation from duly qualified companies or persons.
4. The work done by the IATTC staff

3.3. As the work progressed, particular cases arose that led to very fruitful discussions. These discussions, in accordance with the *Procedures for verifying vessel well volumes* approved in February

2005 at the AIDCP meetings in La Jolla, and taking into account the possible inconsistencies¹ that arose, led the Group to establish criteria for approving the well volume determined for the vessels.

3.4. A vessel's well volume was considered verified if any of the following documents was available:

1. Certificate from a surveying entity recognized by the flag government.
2. Certificate issued by a competent government authority, and supported by a technical study.
3. Certificate from duly qualified companies or persons, endorsed by the flag government and in which there are no inconsistencies.
4. Report by the IATTC staff based on vessel plans, and in which there are no inconsistencies.

3.5. After examining the extant documentation for all the vessels, two lists were drawn up: Vessels whose well volume has been verified (Annex I), and vessels whose well volume could not be verified and must be forwarded for consultation (Annex II).

4. Recommendations to the IRP

4.1. The Group recommends to the IRP that a precondition for including a vessel from Annex II in Annex I is that it provide to the Secretariat any of the documents listed in items 1, 2 and 3 of paragraph 3.4.

¹ The majority of the inconsistencies were related to:

1. Disproportionate relationship between cubic meters of well volume and carrying capacity.
2. Carrying capacity greater than the cubic meters of well volume.
3. Documents not signed.
4. Reports provided by the IATTC staff without having had the vessel plans available.
5. Inadequate documentation.
