4. Actions to promote AIDCP dolphin safe tuna

Mr. Ricardo Belmontes, of the IATTC staff, presented Document [DSP-16-04](#) *Actions for promoting AIDCP dolphin safe tuna*, highlighting the actions carried out by the Secretariat in order to promote the AIDCP and its label. He reported that, as indicated in section 1 of the document, a letter had been sent to the Parties whose fleets fish for tunas associated with dolphins, as well as to the environmental non-governmental organizations that participate in the International Review Panel, to request funds for the preparation of a video promoting the AIDCP.

The delegation of Mexico, after noting that the budget problem was what had affected the Group's work, announced its voluntary contribution of resources to make the preparation of the video possible.

Colombia thanked Mexico for its contribution, and indicated that it was reviewing the matter to evaluate the

possibility of making a contribution in the future.

5. Other business

No other business was discussed.

6. Date and place of next meeting

The next meeting of the Working Group will be held on the dates agreed for the meetings of the AIDCP in 2012.
