REVIEW OF DOLPHIN MORTALITY LIMITS (DMLs) FOR 2015 AND 2016

This report presents details about the utilization of Dolphin Mortality Limits (DMLs) in 2015 and in 2016.

In both years, the overall limit for the fleet has been 5,000, and the portion available for distribution 4,900; the difference constitutes the Reserve DML Allocation (RDA), utilized at the Director's discretion for extraordinary cases.

The situation for 2015 is as follows:
