### CASES OF POSSIBLE NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE *OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR VESSELS* DESCRIBED IN ANNEX VIII OF THE AIDCP AND OCCURRED SINCE THE 69TH MEETING (AND PREVIOUS CASES NOT REVIEWED YET)

During the period since the 69th meeting of the IRP, the Secretariat has reviewed data of 233 fishing trips. Of these, we have two trips with cases of possible non-compliance that the IRP identifies at predetermined form; that is, the Secretariat has been instructed by the IRP to forward them to the Parties for investigation after each meeting.

For this meeting, there are no cases of possible non-compliance that the IRP needs to review.

During this fishing trip, the vessel's net did not have installed the required DSP in the operational requirements for vessels.
