REDUCTION IN THE NUMBER OF MEETINGS

During recent meetings of the Parties to the AIDCP, several delegations have expressed an interest in reducing the number and/or length of AIDCP meetings, mainly because of a reduction in the number of items that need to be addressed.

During the 19th Meeting of the Parties, held in June in Panama, the Secretariat was asked to prepare a proposal for reducing AIDCP meeting time, taking into account any established requirements for meetings.

Table 1 shows the meetings that were held during 2007, and Table 2 the Secretariat's proposal for a reduced meeting schedule. The proposal would reduce the total number of AIDCP meeting days each year from 5.5 to 3.
