AIDCP BUDGET

1. INTRODUCTION

This document presents the actual costs, in US dollars (\$), for 2006, expected budget for 2007 and proposed budget for 2008 to support all costs related to the AIDCP.

The 2003 Resolution on financing the AIDCP (<u>A-03-01</u>) introduced several measures to increase revenue to balance the budget: estimates of vessel well volume, using a multiple of carrying capacity, until the well volumes of all vessels were measured; and assessments for small and inactive purse-seine vessels that are included on the IATTC Regional Vessel Register. The resolution also established payment deadlines for all vessels; if these are not met, a surcharge of 10% of the outstanding assessment is applied.

The 2005 Resolution on financing the AIDCP (A-05-01) raised the vessel assessment rate for 2006 from \$12.552 to \$14.184 per cubic meter of well volume. However, it also provided that the assessments of those vessels whose well volume had been verified should be based on that verified well volume rather than the estimated well volume, which was generally larger.

The 2006 Resolution on financing the AIDCP (<u>A-06-01</u>) raised the vessel assessment rate for 2007 from \$14.184 to \$14.95 per cubic meter of well volume.

During 2006 the Panamanian national program increased its coverage rate, Nicaragua initiated its national program, both of which reduced revenue and, to a lesser extent, costs.

Table 1 shows costs and revenues for 2006 (actual) and 2007-2008 (projected). 2007 revenue is based on actual assessments paid by vessels covered by the AIDCP (over 363 t capacity) plus surcharges both paid and outstanding as of 21 May 2007. The projected revenue for 2008 in Table 1 assumes that all payments are made on time, and projected expenditure incorporates a 3% increase for inflation in costs from the previous year. The projected revenue for 2008 was calculated based on the verified well volumes of the vessels in the IATTC Regional Vessel Register.

The actual revenue for 2006 differs from that reported to the 16th Meeting of the Parties in October 2006 (Document MOP-16-05) because some assessments were received subsequent to that meeting. The projected 2007 revenue in Document MOP-15-08 also differs from the projected revenue in this paper, due to the elimination of assessments for vessels of less than 363 t and the introduction of the Nicaraguan national program, along with the increase in coverage by the Panamanian national program.

2. CURRENT FINANCIAL SITUATION

Table 1 shows actual costs for the IDCP in 2006, and the projected costs and revenue forecast for 2007-2008. The estimate for 2008 assumes that inflation will increase general costs by 3% and salaries by 2.68%. The difference between the 2007 vessel assessments paid by 20 May 2007 and projected AIDCP expenditures is a deficit of \$55.596.

Table 2 shows the line item detail supporting the summary of projected IDCP expenses for 2007 presented in Table 1.

Table 3 shows details of the allocation of the Secretariat staff's time to the IDCP-related tasks they perform.

3. DEFICITS

The AIDCP budget was in deficit from 2002 to 2004, and again in 2006. The deficits for each year and the accumulated deficit are:

The current budget anticipates an accumulated deficit at the end of 2007 of \$585,088.

4. CHANGES IN EXPENDITURE AND INCOME SINCE 2006

During 2006, the increased Panamanian national program coverage, along with the introduction of a new Nicaraguan national program, reduced the related vessel income but did not reduce anticipated expenses in the same proportion. This is because the fixed personnel costs associated with running the IDCP are not reduced by a decrease in the number of IATTC observer placements.

At the 9th Meeting of the Parties in June 2003, charges for small (< 363 t) and inactive vessels and the late payment fee structure were introduced as a step in reducing budget deficits. In June 2006, the 15th Meeting of the Parties eliminated the charges for small vessels. The revenue from inactive and small vessels and late charges in 2006 was \$98,164. As a partial offset to this change in financing, the 16th Meeting of the Parties decided that the Secretariat would retain 100% of fees for late payments and for late charges and inactive vessels, effective immediately. To date, this change in policy has led to a decrease in revenue of \$62,452 in 2007, as reflected in Table 1.

The overall decrease in the 2006 deficit since the first forecast of \$177,554 given at the 15th Meeting of the Parties, compared to the actual deficit of \$74,044, is \$103,510, reducing the current anticipated accumulated deficit at the end of 2007 to \$585,088.
