**PROPOSAL F2**

**SUBMITTED BY PERU**

**RESOLUTION ON THE RESERVE OF CARRYING CAPACITY  
ESTABLISHED IN RESOLUTION C-02-03, BY THE PERUVIAN  
GOVERNMENT**

*The Inter-American Tropical Tuna Commission:*

*Aware* that Peruvian legislation ensures compliance with the commitments acquired in the IATTC and in the Agreement on the International Dolphin Conservation Program, such as the Tuna Fisheries Management Plan, which establishes measures for the conservation of the resource, and following the criteria for responsible fishing adopted internationally,

*Noting* the need to ensure a uniform and equitable treatment of all the members that form part of the IATTC and knowing that the government of Peru has reiterated its reserve on the right to a fleet of 14,046 m<sup>3</sup> of carrying capacity, reflected in Resolution C-02-03, of June 2002,

*Resolves:*

1. To recognize that the reserve of volume of carrying capacity for Peru is equivalent to 14,046 m<sup>3</sup>, including the carrying capacity (3,195 m<sup>3</sup>) that it possesses to date, authorized by Resolution C-02-03.
2. To stipulate that the Peruvian government inform the IATTC opportunely of the names of the vessels to which the tuna-fishing permit is granted, so that they may be included in the IATTC Regional Vessel Register.
