REVIEW OF DOLPHIN MORTALITY LIMITS (DMLs) FOR 2015

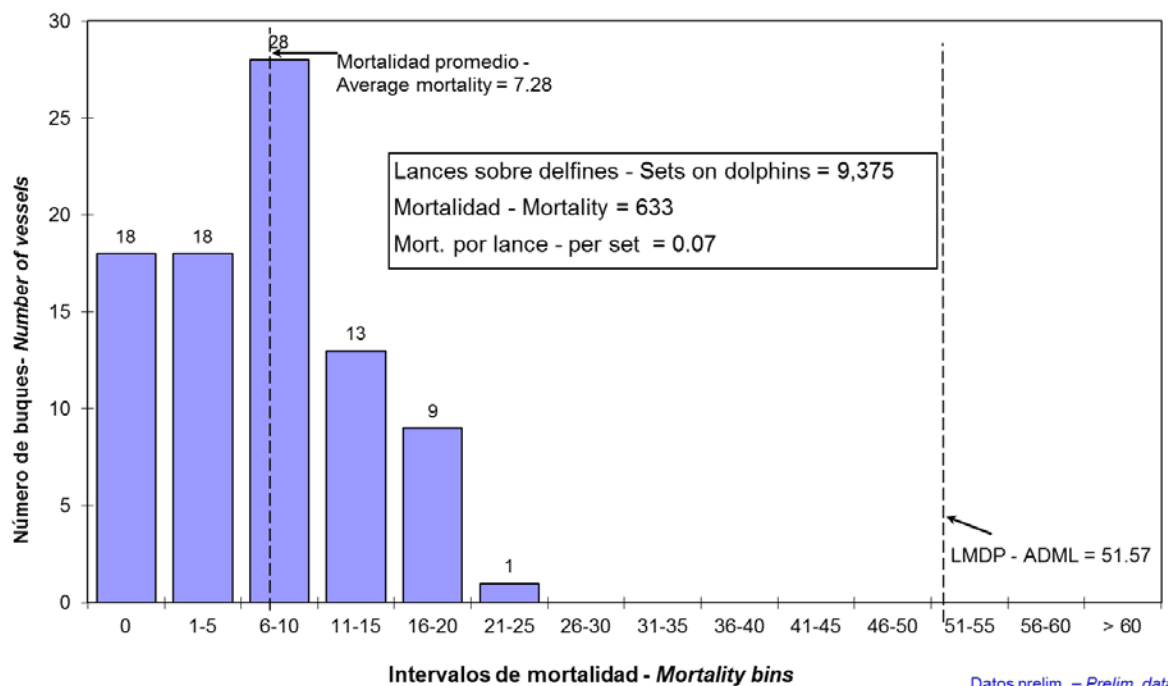
This report presents details about the utilization of Dolphin Mortality Limits (DMLs) in 2015. The overall limit for the fleet is 5,000, and the portion available for distribution is 4,900; the difference constitutes the Reserve DML Allocation (RDA), utilized at the Director's discretion for extraordinary cases.

The current situation (1 October 2015) is as follows:
